## **DIFFERENT OPTIONS OF AGREEMENTS**

Is a short-term, unverified break in **TRUCE** hostilities Is a temporary, <u>unverified</u>, extended **CESSATION OF HOSTILITIES** version of a battlefield truce Is a formal agreement usually monitored **CEASEFIRE AGREEMENT** and verified Is an agreement between two or more hostile PEACE AGREEMENT parties, usually countries or governments, which formally ends a state of war between the parties








## THE FREEZE STEP 1: ESTABLISHMENT OF THE LINE OF CONTROL (LoC)










## **SEPARATION OF FORCES STEP 2: CONCENTRATION OF FORCES**


## **PREPARATORY ACTIVITIES:**

- 1. CEASEFIRE ZONE OR SCOPE OF CEASEFIRE
- 2. DECLARATION OF FORCES' DISPOSITIONS
- 3. PLOTTING ON A MASTER MAP
- 4. IDENTIFY CONTESTED LOCALITIES, POSITIONS OR CITIES
- 5. IDENTIFY SPECIAL AREAS
- 6. IDENTIFY CIVILIAN COMMUNITIES, IDP AND REFUGEE CAMPS THAT NEED PROTECTION OF CIVILIANS
- 7. IDENTIFY NON-SIGNATORY ARMED GROUPS/SPOILERS
- 8. ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATIONALIZATION OF MONITORING AND VERIFICATION MECHANISM
